- Step 5: After you have successfully been accepted, an offer letter will be provided by the University.
- Step 6: If you require a letter of support, you may email your supervisor and make a request.
- Step 7: Update and communicate with your home university as appropriate.
- Step 8: Submit a scholarship application to the China Scholarship Council.
- Step 9: CSC will notify you if your scholarship application is successful.
