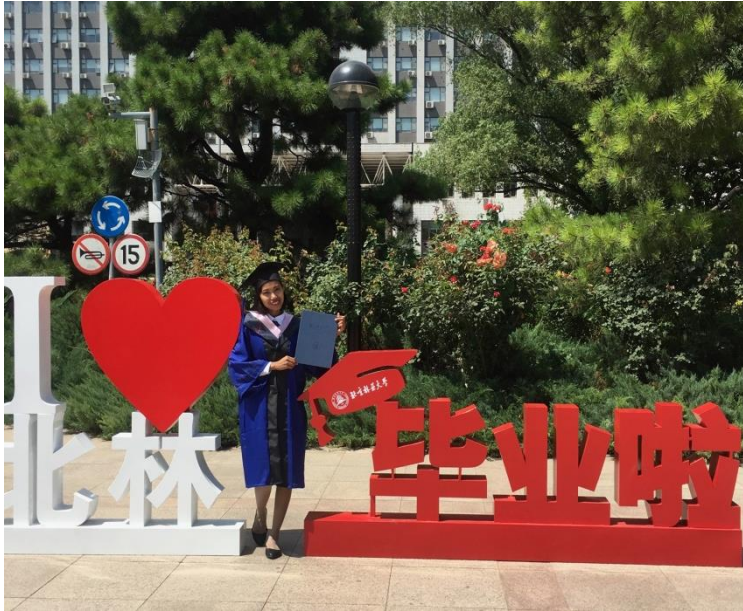


Ekanayake Mudiyansele Buddhika Piumali Ekanayake
